



Try the world of outboard powerboat racing!

TORC Outboard Racing School is an introduction to the sport of Stock Outboard Racing. It is a great first step to learn the sport in a safe environment, get some experience at driving before a first race, or to try the sport and see if it is for you before committing the money on your own race equipment.

The 2023 Outboard Racing School will take place on Friday June 9, at Tweed Memorial Park, in Tweed, Ontario. This is the only School planned for 2023 in Ontario. On site camping and local motels are available if you'd like to stay over Friday night. Racing will take place on Saturday and Sunday if you'd like to stay and watch or participate. Extra fees apply to race.

To secure your spot in the Racer School, fill out the Student Info Form and get your payment in. 2023 only has 8 spots available so don't delay if this School interests you. It sells out every year.

Hydroplanes and Racing Runabouts are used in the school. These are current, up to date race machines. If you have already purchased race equipment, or are returning to racing and taking a refresher course, using your own equipment is encouraged (discount applies).

What to bring to School:

- Shorts and t-shirt that can get wet
- "Wet shoes", closed toed shoes that you don't mind getting wet. No Crocs. Should fit snug. Many use old running shoes.
- Dry clothes/shoes for after School
- If possible, bring your own good condition Snell 2010+ approved full coverage helmet and eye protection (visor or goggles)
- Optional: Gloves (PWC or motocross gloves work well), Lawn chair, Sun screen, Water or sports drink and snack/lunch.
- Action camera like a go-pro and a picture camera are also great to bring. (please share your pics/video afterwards)

On day of school, you will enter the park and head to the posted pit area to register by filling out forms and waivers for the various race associations and race club involved with the school. These are to be filled out by the student on site and anyone in attendance with them. If the student is a minor, a legal guardian must be present or some forms must be prearranged. The fees cover the student with insurance for the weekend should they wish to be involved in helping out with the races on the Saturday or Sunday.

A select few seats are available for students to then also race on Saturday and/or Sunday, additional fees apply. If this might interest you, please let us know and we'll fill you in on the process.
